

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PETROLIA

BY-LAW NUMBER 45-2012

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PETROLIA
RESPECTING THE CONSERVATION OF WATER

WHEREAS section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, c. 25 gives The Corporation of the Town of Petrolia the power to pass by-laws respecting water production, treatment and storage;

AND WHEREAS section 8 (3) of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001m c, 25 gives The Corporation of the Town of Petrolia the power to regulate or prohibit activities respecting its jurisdiction over water production, treatment and storage;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality enacts as follows:

1. No person shall water or sprinkle, or cause or permit the watering or sprinkling of any lawn, garden, tree, shrub or other outdoor plant in the Town of Petrolia thought a hose or other attachment connected to the municipal water system **except between the hours of 5:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.; and between 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. subject to the following:**


(a) Premises with municipal address having even numbers may sprinkle or water within the designated time only on even-numbered days;

(b) Premises with municipal address having odd numbers may sprinkle or water within the designated time only on odd-numbered days;


2. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to a fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), exclusive of costs, for each offence recoverable under the Provincial Offense Act;

3. This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon third reading and the final passing thereof.

This By-Law read a First, Second and Third Time and Finally Passed this 16th, day of July, 2012
