T16-01 Tenders for Petrolia Line Reconstruction Kerby Street to Fletcher Street

Tenders, sealed in an envelope which shall be clearly marked as to contents, will be received by the Town of Petrolia, **411 Greenfield Street, Petrolia, Ontario N0N 1R0**, until 2:00 p.m. local time, as recorded by the Town of Petrolia on the date and at the place of tender, on

Thursday, April 7, 2016

for the construction of the works described below.

On the same day, commencing at 2:05 p.m. local time, the tenders will be opened and read publicly by the Town of Petrolia, at the above-mentioned address.

The work consists generally of the supplying of materials, labour and equipment for the reconstruction of Petrolia Line, including:

- Supply and installation of approximately 550 m of 300mm watermain, including temporary service, appurtenances and service connections complete. Work will include connection to the interior plumbing of all street-fronting buildings, and installation of Owner supplied water meters and back-flow preventers;
- Supply and installation of approximately 505 m of 375mm to 865x1350mm HE storm sewer, including catchbasins, service connections, and associated appurtenances;
- Complete removal and reconstruction of the road surface, including sidewalks and boulevards;
- Replacement of streetlights.

Complete tender documents may be obtained from **CIMA+**, **101 Frederick Street, Suite 900, Kitchener, Ontario, N2H 6R2**, after March 17th, 2016.

Each tender must be accompanied by a tender deposit in the form of a certified cheque or bid bond in the amount of \$95,000.00, made payable to the Town of Petrolia.

A copy of the soils report will be passed to those who take out tender documents.

During the tender period, test pits will be dug within the limits of the Contract, to enable tenderers to observe soil conditions first hand. Test pits will be dug on **Thursday, March 31st, 2016**, commencing at 10:00 a.m., on **Petrolia Line** at Fletcher Street.

Tender documents may be studied without payment at the Consulting Engineer's office (address below) or the usual construction association offices.

Tenders are subject to a formal contract being prepared and executed.

The Tenderer agrees that the Town has the right, at its own discretion, to accept or reject any non-compliant tenders without stating the reasons therefore and that the lowest or any tender will not necessarily be accepted.

The Tenderer understands that fundamental to this competition is the selection of a tender that, in the Town's opinion, is in the best interest of the Town. To this end, the Tenderer agrees that the Town reserves the right to select a winning tender that may be non-compliant.
