**Heavy Truck Restrictions in Place on Petrolia Line**  
Tuesday, November 15, 2016

**Wyoming, ON** - With the reopening of County Road 4 (Petrolia Line) in the Town of Petrolia, heavy trucks permitted to travel through the Town are now restricted to those making a local pickup or delivery.

The new restrictions were endorsed by Lambton County Council at its May 4, 2016 meeting.

A heavy truck is defined as a commercial motor vehicle with a registered gross vehicle weight of 28,600 kilograms or more. These trucks typically are categorized as those with four (4) or more axles such as tractor trailers and tanker trucks.

The County's Public Works Department is reaching out to organizations whose trucks are known to pass through the Town to notify them of the new restrictions.

Signage is also being installed at various locations on the County Road system to appropriately direct heavy vehicles.
