BY-LAW NUMBER 10 - 2015

A BY-LAW TO CONFIRM THE COMMITMENT OF THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PETROLIA
TO PROTECT THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF ITS WORKERS.

WHEREAS the Occupational Health and Safety Act came into force on October 1st, 1979;

AND WHEREAS the Employer must commit to protect the health and safety of its workers;

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PETROLIA
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

THAT The Corporation of the Town of Petrolia (the employer) is committed to protect the health and safety of its workers. The Corporation of the Town of Petrolia will make every effort to provide a safe and healthy work environment. The employer, senior management, supervisors and workers are dedicated to reduce injuries and illnesses in the workplace;

THAT the employer is responsible for worker health and safety, as set out by the Occupational Health and Safety Act and regulations and related legislation. The Corporation of the Town of Petrolia headed by its Mayor and Council commits that every reasonable precaution is taken for the protection of all workers;

THAT Managers and Supervisors are responsible and accountable for the health and safety of workers under their supervision;

THAT every worker must protect their own health and safety and work in compliance with the Occupation Health and Safety Act and regulations and those policies and programs as set out by the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia;

THAT a healthy and safe work environment is everyone's responsibility;

AND THAT all By-Laws and motions of Council found to be inconsistent with the Provisions found in this By-Law shall be and are Hereby Repealed;

NOW THEREFORE this By-law shall become effective and take force upon passing.
