Your Responsibilities as a **PROPERTY OWNER**

The Town of Petrolia would like to remind property owners of the following responsibilities that apply to your property and its use:

- Please ensure that your property is generally well-maintained, free of waste/ refuse and drained at all times.
- All buildings, structures, landscaping (including tree planting) and any other features must be kept within the boundaries of your property.
- No waste of any kind is to be deposited onto another property.
- No clearing or change of vegetation is allowed on property that is outside your property's boundaries.
- Ensure that no drainage waters are diverted to neighbouring or municipal properties.
- Weeds and grass are to be maintained at a height of 8 inches (20 cm) or less.
- Ensure pool water, surface drainage and grading is maintained on your property and that it does not affect neighbouring properties.
- Ensure pool backwash waters are not discharged to sanitary or storm outlets and that all drainage is maintained within your property's boundaries

- If you have a swimming pool or plan to install a swimming pool, you must comply with the Municipal Pool By-Law and the pool and fence/enclosure must be maintained in accordance with the By-law
- Any structure which is 108 square feet (including covered areas) or less does not require a building permit, but the structure must comply with all applicable law, which includes the Petrolia Zoning By-law and the Ontario Building Code. Any structure larger than 108 square feet is subject to building permit issuance.
- Please take notice that if any Municipal By-Law violation(s) is not remedied within the time specified in an issued Order, the Municipality may correct such violation by repair or clearance at the expense of the Owner and without further notice to the Owner and without all expenses associated with the administration and enforcement of all Municipal By-Laws.
- The Town of Petrolia thanks all residents for their efforts in keeping the Town an attractive and quality community.

A helpful guide to keep in mind:

- Please flatten your cardboard and keep it smaller than $36" \times 12"$.
- Rinse your recyclables.
- No masks or gloves.
- · Waxed cardboard is not accepted.
- No plastic bags.
- · No diapers, or household wipes.
- Styrofoam is not recyclable.
- Any paper items are recyclable but remember to remove personal information prior to recycling.

it will be processed.



Income Tax Program Overview

The Inn of the Good Shepherd's Income Tax program provides low-income individuals a FREE opportunity to have their taxes completed. With the help of our team of volunteers and community partners, The Inn is able to organize Mobile Tax Clinics from March to April, both in Sarnia and the county. The Inn is also a Drop Off Hub, where individuals can drop their tax information off, and our volunteers will complete it on their behalf and follow-up with their refund information. Our John St. location will also do taxes by appointments starting on March 1st, every Mon-Thurs from 2:30pm — 3:30pm. We will start booking appointments after February 22nd, 2021.

2019 Tax Season

- our team completed almost 3100 income tax returns
 - those returns generated \$13 million in additional benefits for vulnerable folks
 - GST, Child Tax Benefits, Ontario Trillium Benefit, Carbon Tax Refund, Guaranteed Income Supplement, Property Tax Credit, etc.
 - Key benefits that can be overlooked but make significant impact for individuals with a low or very fixed income
- 40% of all individuals who access out Income Tax Program do not use ANY other services from The Inn
 - The returns and benefits we are able to assist with, provide avenues away from needing our other services

WINTER MAINTENANCE NOTICE

Snow Removal

- Under the Highway Traffic Act Section 181 Deposit of snow on Roadway, states that "No person shall deposit snow or ice on a roadway without permission in writing to do so from the Ministry of Transportation or the road authority responsible for the maintenance of the road.'
- This generally applies to the snow that accumulates in laneways from precipitation and from private or municipal snow plowing operations, those who insist on plowing snow from private property onto public roads can be fined

Overnight Parking

- Residents are reminded there is no overnight parking on Town streets between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- This allows for the Town's Road Crews to plow the roads safely and efficiently, we ask that you please abide by the by-law and be considerate of the road crews when they are out doing their best to keep our roads open and in safe condition

Parking on roadway

· Under the Highway Traffic Act Section 170.

Vehicles interfering with traffic

(12) Despite the other provisions of this section, no person shall park or stand a vehicle on a highway in such a manner as to interfere with the movement of traffic or the clearing of snow from the highway. R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8, s. 170 (12).

Sidewalks

- Under By-Law Business owners are required to maintain the front area of their storefront, this includes the removal of snow
- The Sidewalk Plow will make its way through Town once permittable, Roads are the priority for Works Crew once they are clear Sidewalks

Sporting Equipment


