Your Responsibilities as a **PROPERTY OWNER**

The Town of Petrolia would like to remind property owners of the following responsibilities that apply to your property and its use:

- Please ensure that your property is generally well-maintained, free of waste/ refuse and drained at all times.
- All buildings, structures, landscaping (including tree planting) and any other features must be kept within the boundaries of your property.
- No waste of any kind is to be deposited onto another property.
- No clearing or change of vegetation is allowed on property that is outside your property's boundaries.
- Ensure that no drainage waters are diverted to neighbouring or municipal properties
- Weeds and grass are to be maintained at a height of 8 inches (20 cm) or less.
- Ensure pool water, surface drainage and grading is maintained on your property and that it does not affect neighbouring properties.
- Ensure pool backwash waters are not discharged to sanitary or storm outlets and that all drainage is maintained within your property's boundaries.

- If you have a swimming pool or plan to install a swimming pool, you must comply with the Municipal Pool By-Law and the pool and fence/enclosure must be maintained in accordance with the By-law
- Any structure which is 108 square feet (including covered areas) or less does not require a building permit, but the structure must comply with all applicable law, which includes the Petrolia Zoning By-law and the Ontario Building Code. Any structure larger than 108 square feet is subject to building
- Please take notice that if any Municipal By-Law violation(s) is not remedied within the time specified in an issued Order, the Municipality may correct such violation by repair or clearance at the expense of the Owner and without further notice to the Owner - which includes all expenses associated with the administration and enforcement of all Municipal By-Laws.
- The Town of Petrolia thanks all residents for their efforts in keeping the Town an attractive and quality community.

Recycle all empty plastic bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.

Keep food and liquids out of the recycling.

Empty recyclables directly into your cart
- NO bagged recyclables.

A helpful guide to keep in mind:

- Please flatten your cardboard and keep it smaller than 36" x 12".
- Rinse your recyclables.
- No masks or gloves.
- Waxed cardboard is not accepted.
- No plastic bags.
- No diapers, or household wipes.
- Styrofoam is not recyclable.
- Any paper items are recyclable but remember to remove personal information prior to recycling.





Garden of Hope Planted in Petrolia

Petrolia will be awash in red and white flowers and plants this summer, but one downtown garden will be bright yellow and known as the Petrolia Garden of Hope.

The "Garden of Hope" idea is one that is gaining traction across Canada and beyond, with the idea to see the land awash with gardens featuring yellow, the international colour of hope.

The professional trade association of Canadian Nursery Landscape Association (CNLA) first endeavours is the Hope is Growing campaign, in partnership with Garden Centres Canada, are encouraging Canadians to plant gardens of hope for 2021 and featuring the colour yellow. From coast to coast, the goal is to create front yards, boulevards and playgrounds brimming with yellow flowers, foliage, and vegetables.

You can take part by planting your Hope Garden and sharing it on social media, and by looking for Hope is Growing displays at participating retail garden centres.

Petrolia in Bloom volunteers have chosen the garden in front of the plaza with Johnny G's Pizza and Wise Guys Inc. as the home for this bright and vibrant yellow garden.

Dave Menzies, Director of Facilities and Community Services said, "It has truly been a difficult fourteen months for Petrolia residents and our intention is that this bright yellow garden will be a ray of sunshine that people can enjoy on their own time and reflect on their hope for the future. Canadians took up gardening in record numbers last year and so far, the trend is continuing in 2021.

Signs will be in the garden so that residents and visitors will understand the significance.

TEMPORARY CURBSIDE COMPOST COLLECTION DURING PROVINCIAL STAY-AT-HOME ORDER

Following the extension of the Provincial Stay-At-Home Order, the opening of the Compost Transfer Site will be delayed until JUNE 5, 2021, however, a curbside solution has been put in place for residents to dispose of their compost items in lieu of opening the Transfer Site.

Temporary Curbside Collection will prevent gathering at the Site and will provide an exceptional level of service to residents in Petrolia while they wait for the Site to be available.

The dates for curbside compost collection are:

WEDNESDAY, MAY 19, 2021 WEDNESDAY, MAY 26, 2021 WEDNESDAY, JUNE 2, 2021

Rules for Curbside Compost Collection:

All compost must be in paper bags only or it will not be collected.

See the existing list (below) of acceptable and not acceptable items.

Anything that is non-compostable will not be picked up.

Please keep your brush and sticks for when the Transfer Site opens.

Curbside Compost is to be placed at the curb no earlier than 7:00 p.m. on the Tuesday evening.

Following the same health and safety guidelines as the Curbside Wood Chipping, we ask residents to refrain from interacting with public works staff while they are working and forward any questions to Town Hall at (519)882-2350.

Looking Ahead to June 5 - Maude Street Transfer Site

Starting on June 5, for the 2021 season, the Petrolia Compost Transfer Site will be located at 546 Maude Street Extension, Petrolia.

Passes are required to access the site. Passes are complimentary for 2021 and due to the COVID-19 restrictions and the current stay at home order we ask that residents call ahead or send an email to obtain your pass:

Please call (519)882-2350 and leave a message to obtain a pass, a staff member will return your call and verify your address and create a pass for you.

Residents can also obtain a pass by sending an e-mail to jsmith@petrolia.ca.

Passes will be held for pick up at the Transfer Site and can be picked up on your first visit. Note: the pass holder must be present with identification to pick up the pass.

Access is for residents of Petrolia only, and passes are non-transferable.
