Victoria Playhouse Petrolia (VPP) is thrilled to announce exciting re-opening plans for 2021 with a brand new, special event called **"Songs We Love."** Running September 7 through October 3, the show celebrates patron favourites from past productions, as well as a sneak peek at what's to come for 2022.

Featuring Alex Baerg, Michael Vanhevel, Jennifer Walls and lead by the theatre's resident music director, Mark Payne, the show will take audiences on a musical journey of the past ten years and provide a glimpse into the future.

Keeping patrons' safety at the forefront of all planning, there will be some new measures in place. Understanding that patrons have been awaiting news about the postponed 2020/2021 Season, the decision has been made to move the entire six show line up to 2022. Guests holding tickets still for **The Roaring Twenties, On Golden Pond, Dynamic Duos, The Power of Song 2: Divine Women, When Irish Eyes are Smiling** and **Wingfield: Lost & Found** are asked to remain patient as box office staff will begin calling ticket holders in the upcoming months to confirm new dates. As previously outlined, patrons will be offered their original seats and day of the week booked for the 2020 season. Staff will also make any changes necessary, as available, at the patron's request. Your Responsibilities as a PROPERTY OWNER

The Town of Petrolia would like to remind property owners of the following responsibilities that apply to your property and its use:

- Please ensure that your property is generally well-maintained, free of waste/refuse and drained at all times.
- All buildings, structures, landscaping (including tree planting) and any other features must be kept within the boundaries of your property.
- No waste of any kind is to be deposited onto another property.
- No clearing or change of vegetation is allowed on property that is outside your property's boundaries.
- Ensure that no drainage waters are diverted to neighbouring or municipal properties.
- Weeds and grass are to be maintained at a height of 8 inches (20 cm) or less.
- Ensure pool water, surface drainage and grading is maintained on your property and that it does not affect neighbouring properties.
- Ensure pool backwash waters are not discharged to sanitary or storm outlets and that all drainage is maintained within your property's boundaries.
- If you have a swimming pool or plan to install a swimming pool, you must comply with the Municipal Pool By-Law and the pool and fence/enclosure must be maintained in accordance with the By-law.
- Any structure which is 108 square feet (including covered areas) or less does not require a building permit, but the structure must comply with all applicable law, which includes the Petrolia Zoning By-law and the Ontario Building Code. Any structure larger than 108 square feet is subject to building permit issuance.
- Please take notice that if any Municipal By-Law violation(s) is not remedied within the time specified in an issued Order, the Municipality may correct such violation by repair or clearance at the expense of the Owner and without further notice to the Owner - which includes all expenses associated with the administration and enforcement of all Municipal By-Laws.
- The Town of Petrolia thanks all residents for their efforts in keeping the Town an attractive and quality community.

Keep food and liquids out of the recycling.
-  **3** 
Empty recyclables directly into your cart - NO bagged recyclables.

A helpful guide to keep in mind:

- Please flatten your cardboard and keep it smaller than 36" x 12".
- Rinse your recyclables.
- No masks or gloves.
- Waxed cardboard is not accepted.
- No plastic bags.
- No diapers, or household wipes.
- Styrofoam is not recyclable.
- Any paper items are recyclable but remember to remove personal information prior to recycling.


