The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting via video conference on Tuesday, October 12, 2021. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Received a letter from a resident requesting consideration of a skate park, and directed that staff refer it to the Community Services Advisory Committee for further input and discussion.
