September 27, 2021– 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting via video conference on Monday, September 27, 2021. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Received an update regarding planning and development, and that several projects are moving along well.
- Received an update that Greenfield Street is nearing completion, Wingfield Street is ready for the topcoat of asphalt and other fall activities including compost and leaf collection will be proceeding shortly.
- Received an update about Community Events, and about Parks activities, and the return of ice to Greenwood Recreation Centre.
- Received an update on the cemetery tour.
- Received an update on the Petrolia 150 Committee event planning.
- Received an update from Ken Melanson, County of Lambton Manager of Planning & Development Services regarding increased Planner Hours at Town Hall and the introduction of Planner, Phil Rough.
- Approved a Sidewalk Connectivity Proposal with BM Ross for 2021 and 2022.
- Approved an advertising agreement with Bluewater Power, Damar Security and the IODE Margret Stokes Chapter from September 2021 through to May of 2026 for the Greenwood Recreation Centre Olympia.
- Approved a temporary road closure of Station Street between Petrolia Line and Railroad Street on October 23, 2021, from 7 am to 7 pm for the "expanded" Lambton Central Petrolia Optimist Club outdoor craft sale; and approved that the rental fees associated with this event at the Farmers Market be waived for the Lambton Central Petrolia Optimist Club.
- Approved that the North side of Victoria Hall be illuminated in orange on Thursday, September 30, 2021, in recognition of National Truth and Reconciliation Day.
