

# Council News in Brief

March 28, 2022– 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting via video conference on Monday, February 14, 2022. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Heard a delegation from OCWA regarding the Brights Grove Water Treatment Plant Annual Report
- Received a report regarding the 2022 Compost Transfer Site dates, and requested that staff add two dates, one additional one in July and one additional one in August.
- Received and approved a capital budget increase of \$10,645.00 for the supply of a ½ tonne pick up truck and that the RFP be awarded to Blue Mountain Chrysler.
- Received a report regarding 2022 R1 & R2 tenders and awarded the tender to Sevcon Construction in the amount of \$231,006.11 excluding HST.
- Received a report regarding the procurement of the 3-tonne compact excavator and directed Operations to proceed with the purchase through Southpoint Equipment in the amount of \$49,735.00 for a Kubota Mini Excavator.
- Received a report regarding the Valentine Street reconstruction and awarded the contract to Cope Construction and Contracting Inc. in the amount of \$288,427.00 excluding HST.
- Granted “Significant Community Festival/Event” status to the following 2022 Town of Petrolia Community Events: Pizzafest, Canada Day – Rock the Park, Art in the Park, Barn Dance, and Harvestfest.
- Received a report regarding the 2021 Achievements and Activities.
- Adopted a report regarding the 2022 Garden Centre at Heidi’s Your Independent Grocer and that a temporary meter be installed and water usage to be billed at the end of the season.
- Received a report regarding the 2021 Statistics Canada Census results.
- Received a report regarding vital statistics and meeting attendance update for 2021.
- Received a report regarding 2021 council remuneration and expenses and annual public sector disclosure filing.
- Received a report regarding COVID-19 Government Announced Support.
- Adopted a report regarding revisions to By-Law #66-2019 regarding Establishing and Regulating By-Law Revisions.
- Adopted a report regarding the hazardous response agreement with Plympton-Wyoming and authorized the Mayor and Clerk to execute a by-law agreement.
- Received a report regarding the Petrolia and North Enniskillen Fire Department Annual Report for 2021.
- Received a report regarding training requirement mandates for Fire Departments.
