

Project Overview

- Road reconstruction project includes (Undergrounds):
 - <u>Sanitary</u>
 - Existing sanitary sewer is in good condition and will remain.
 - Exposing existing sanitary cleanouts.
 - Installation of a sanitary force main on Third St from First Ave to Kentail St to support future development.
 - <u>Storm</u>
 - Addition of new storm sewers complete with storm services to property line.
 - <u>Water</u>
 - Replacement of current watermain and services.
 - Upgrading Kentail St watermain to 300mm diameter to support future development.
 - Temporary water service throughout construction.




Project Overview

- Road reconstruction project includes (Surface Features):
 - <u>Roadway</u>
 - Removal and replacement of asphalt surface and road base.
 - Addition of curb and gutter.
 - Curb face sidewalk on one side of the road.
 - Boulevard and driveway restoration (to property line).
 - Reconstruction of Kerr Park parking lot.






Third Street – Overall Plan View

- Sidewalk on the north side




Third Street – Overall Plan View

- Sidewalk on the north side




Kentail Street – Overall Plan View

Tentative Project Schedule

- Contractor scheduled to mobilize to site: Monday June 6, 2022
- Cleanup and contractor demobilization: October 2022
- Top coat asphalt: Summer 2023



Notes For Local Residents

- Precondition survey of residential properties
 - Third party, MIT Inspections, hired to document the existing interior and exterior conditions of buildings within the construction area.
 - A "Notice of Inspection" letter will be mailed separately.



Notes For Local Residents

- Vehicle access will be limited during working hours (7:00am to 7:00pm Monday to Friday)
 - Residents are encouraged to park on adjacent streets to ensure vehicles are accessible during working hours.
 - Excavations are backfilled at the end of each day to allow vehicle access.
 - Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Garbage collection
 - No change for residents, bring garbage to curbside during regularly scheduled collection days. Contractor to move garbage for pick up as needed.
 - Clearly label containers with your address.
