

Council News in Brief

April 25, 2022– 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person at Victoria Hall, Petrolia on Monday April 28, 2022. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Hosted a Public Meeting at 6:00 p.m. to discuss the Valentina Street Reconstruction Project
- Received the Financial Accounts list.
- Adopted a report that will see that Baker Tilley be awarded the external audit services contract from 2022 to 2026 fiscal years in the total amount of \$125,900 (excluding HST) and accept the optional services for production of the Financial Information Return if needed; and endorsed the appointment By-law.
- Directed staff to apply for a grant opportunity from the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Municipal Asset Management Program; and that the Town of Petrolia commits to conducting the following activities in its proposed project submitted to the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Municipal Asset Management Program to advance our asset management program:
 - Update our Asset Management Plan, and
 - Improve Data Integrity of Citywide (Town's Asset Register)
 - Council also committed \$15,000 from its 2022 and 2023 in budget toward the costs of this initiative.
- Adopted a report regarding the tender results for the Third/Mutual/Kentail reconstruction project; and awarded Henry Heyink Construction Ltd. the re-construction contract in the amount of \$ 1,704,239.80 + HST.
- Received and filed the grant application results of the 2022 Platinum Jubilee of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II – Community Projects; and approved that staff proceed with planned celebrations.
- Received and filed a report regarding the Town of Petrolia 2022 Signature Events.
- Received and filed a report regarding the Victoria Playhouse Petrolia Ticket Sales report.
- Met in camera to discuss:
 - Sec 239(2) of the Act
 - personal matters about an identifiable individual, including municipal or local board employees; Aird & Berlis communication to council
- Rise & Report, Mayor Loosley reported:
 - That Council will receive further details at the May 24, 2022, meeting.
