

Council News in Brief

May 9, 2022– 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person at Victoria Hall, Petrolia on Monday, May 9, 2022. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Hosted a Public Meeting at 5:00 p.m. to discuss the proposed Zoning By-Law Amendment Petrolia Sky Estates.
- Hosted a Public Meeting at 6:00 p.m. to discuss the proposed Zoning By-Law Amendment and proposed Official Plan Amendment 637.
- Received a report regarding the long-term debt analysis.
- Received a report regarding the 2022 First Quarterly Financial Report.
- Approved a report regarding the PSD CityWide proposal to update our 2017 Town Asset Management Plan and improve the data integrity of our CityWide asset registry for \$39,500.
- Approved a report regarding the Petrolia Enniskillen Agricultural Society an exemption to the noise bylaw, a Parade and Significant Community Event Status for their annual fall fair on September 9, 10, 11 of 2022
- Approved a report regarding the Events Team request to close Wingfield Street from Petrolia Line to Walnut and the south parking lane of Petrolia Line between Greenfield Street and Wingfield Street on Saturday June 4 from 7am to 11pm for the annual Pizzafest Event.
- Approved the signing of a contribution agreement with the Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario (FedDev) in regards to the Canada Community Revitalization Fund Grant; and that \$233,000.00 be taken from the working capital reserves to balance the project; and that MIG Engineering be appointed Project Manager / Consultant; and endorsed the By-law included with the Council meeting.
- Endorsed a report regarding the awarding of the mechanical work as listed in the RFQ to Sarnia Plumbing and Mechanical in the amount of \$398,750 plus HST.

Council will meet on Tuesday, May 24, 2022, at 6 p.m. for a public information meeting regarding Third/Mutual and Kentail, and then for a Regular Council Meeting at 7 p.m. The meetings will be in-person in the Council Chambers at Victoria Hall and available by via video conference following the meeting.
