NOTICE TO PROPERTY NOXIOUS WEEDS & LONG GRASS

Notice is hereby given to all persons in possession of land, in accordance with the Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter W.5, Section 3, 16, and 23.

That unless noxious weeds growing on their lands within the municipality of the Town of Petrolia are destroyed throughout the season, the municipality may enter upon the said lands and have the weeds destroyed, charging the cost against the land, plus an administration charge as set out in the Act. (Minimum charge per parcel is \$50.)

Long Grass

By-law 80 of 2008 specifies that "weeds and grass shall not be permitted to grow or stand greater than 20 centimeters (8 inches) in height." Under Section 9.4 and Section 10, if grass is not kept under 20 cm or 8 inches, the Town after notice is given will cut the property grass at the owner's

Blowing Grass Trimmings to the Roadway All grass blown onto the roadway during lawn maintenance is not be left on the roadway or disposed of into catch basins.

The cooperation of all landowners is appreciated.

Residents are asked to place the brush no sooner that 4:00pm, the night before a collection date, and to have all brush at the curb by 7:00 am the day of collection, and are requested to not impede sidewalk access.

Tree limbs and branches can not exceed 4" in diameter.

Not permittable items include hedge clippings, vines, roots, perennials and any other compostable materials. Resident will be responsible for removal.



Are you on the Voter's List?

Unsure if you are on the voter's list for the upcoming Municipal Election? Haven't received your Voter Information letter in the mail (mailed out in late September 2022)? Call 519-882-2350 or email election@petrolia.ca to confirm if you are on the list!

The voters' list is a list of eligible electors in the Town of Petrolia. The Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC) is responsible for preparing the preliminary list of electors for each municipality and school board in Ontario. It is MPAC's database of property owners and tenants that is used to prepare this preliminary list, which aids in the preparation of the final voters' list for Election Day.

If you have moved, changed your name, or purchased property since the last municipal election MPAC may not have received this update. Even if you have recently voted in the provincial election, we encourage you to ensure that the Town of Petrolia has the current voter information for you. The onus is on the elector to ensure you are on the Voter's List.

Through MPAC's hosted www.voterlookup.ca many electors provided updated information, thank you! Update information completed through voterlookup.ca is being processed, all electors who added themselves to the Voter's List will receive their Voter Information letter by October 7, 2022

Alternatively, voters are able to attend the municipal office to complete the required Application to Amend Voters List. To amend the list, you must have acceptable identification, which includes an Ontario driver's license, an Ontario Health Card, an insurance policy or statement or any other document included on the acceptable documents for voter identification list. Applications can be completed right through to Election Day!

Once an elector has been added to the Voter's List you will be issued, a Voter PIN.

Who Can Vote/Tenant?

A *person* is entitled to vote in a municipal election if he or she on voting day:

- Resides in the local municipality, or is the owner or tenant of land in the municipality, or is the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- Is a Canadian Citizen; and
- Is at least 18 years old: and
- Is not prohibited from voting under the Municipal Elections Act, as amended, or otherwise prohibited by law;

Canada Post

If Electors have not provided their most current mailing information to MPAC, please contact our Municipal Office to provide that updated information.

If you were an elector who previously had only a PO Box mailing address, please be sure that you have provided us with your most current mailing address, that does not include the PO Box program, as eliminated by Canada Post.

In the event of a Canada Post strike, all Voter Information letters issued after September 23, 2022 will be available for pick up at the Municipal Office, with proper identification provided.

If you are an elector who is unable to make it to the Municipal Office, please contact the Clerks Department to make alternate arrangements.

- Please flatten your cardboard and keep it smaller than 36" x 12".
- Rinse your recyclables.
- No masks or gloves.
- Waxed cardboard is not accepted.
- No plastic bags.
- No diapers, or household wipes.
- Styrofoam is not recyclable.
- Any paper items are recyclable but remember to remove personal information prior to recycling.





Persons may be nominated as candidates in the Municipal Election for the positions set out below by filing a nomination paper in the prescribed form along with a \$100 filing fee payable by cash, certified cheque or money order. Identification of the candidate must be produced at the time the nomination paper is submitted. A \$200.00 filing fee is required for the Head of Council of a Municipality.

Nomination papers may be filed anytime during normal office hours from May 2, 2022, to Thursday, August 18th, 2022. On Nomination Day, Friday, August 19th, 2022, nomination papers may be filed anytime between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Nomination papers shall be filed at the office of the Clerk of the Municipality in which a person intends to run for office, or in the case of School Board, the office of the Clerk designated to receive nominations for that particular office. Nomination forms and full particulars of the nomination process can be obtained from the office of the Clerk in which nomination papers must be filed.

Where more certified candidates are nominated for an office than the number required to fill the office, an election will be held

If, by 2:00 p.m. on Friday, August 19th, 2022, the number of certified candidates nominated for an office does not exceed the number of vacancies, those nominated will be acclaimed to office. Additional nominations for any remaining vacancies will be accepted on Wednesday, August 24th, 2022, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.
