

# Council News in Brief

June 13, 2022– 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person at Victoria Hall, Petrolia on Monday, June 13, 2022. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Hosted a Public Information Meeting at 6:00 p.m. to review a rezoning request from Countryside Realty and to update the school definition.
- Heard a delegation from Ms. Dasha Peregoudova of Aird & Berlis LLP Council received and filed the report and thanked Ms. Peregoudova for her time.
- Council received a report regarding the current grant summary.
- Council received a report regarding sports equipment on streets and directed staff to add the wording to a by-law.
- Received a report regarding County of Lambton Site Plan Delegation.
- Adopted a report regarding a contribution agreement with the Federal Economic Development Agency for Southwestern Ontario and that the Mayor and CAO be authorized to sign said agreement.
- Received a report regarding the Judith and Norman Alix Foundation grant to the Victoria Playhouse Petrolia.
- Under new business, in a report from Mayor R. Brad Loosley, Council requested staff to proceed with communication with the Lambton Kent District School Board in regard to a rainbow crosswalk and to return to Council with price estimates when able.
