

Council News in Brief

June 27, 2022– 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person at Victoria Hall, Petrolia on Monday, June 27, 2022. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Hosted a Public Information Meeting at 6:00 p.m. regarding a sidewalk study.
- Council appointed Mayor R. Brad Loosley and Chief Administrative Officer Rick Charlebois to Bluewater Power Distribution Corporation and its affiliates; appointed Brad Goodhill as the Auditors of the Corporation; confirmed the re-appointment of KPMG; acknowledged receipt of audited financial statements dated April 30, 2022; and confirmed all actions in the prior year, including the declaration of dividends as evidenced in the financial statements.
- Council approved a request from Elbee Investments for an extension of draft plan approval.
- Council approved a request from Enniskillen Pepper Company to rescind the Site Plan Agreement for By-Law 52-2019 and 56-2109 (Kingswell Hotel Phase I and II).
- Council received a delegation from Mr. Giovanni Spadafora of Baker Tilley regarding the 2021 Audited Financial Statements
- Resident Diane O'Dell was presented with an Ontario Senior of the Year Award from Mayor R. Brad Loosley
- Participating pizzerias were presented with plaques commemorating the 2022 Petrolia Pizzafest, and then they presented the Petrolia Community Foundation with a donation in the amount of \$1802.00.
- Council adopted the draft 2021 audited financial statements as presented.
- Council received and filed a report regarding the 2021 Financial Information Return (FIR).
- Council received and filed a report regarding the internal controls document draft and adopted the Internal Controls Policy.
- Council endorsed the transfer of the 2021 Town General Operating Surplus to the working Capital Reserve.
- Notice of Motion from Councillor Don Welten was rescinded and will be added to the July agenda.
- Notice of Motion from Councillor Wade Deighton was approved regarding a request to the CAO for an update on the attrition management plan.
