NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS NOXIOUS WEEDS & LONG GRASS

Weeds

Notice is hereby given to all persons in possession of land, in accordance with the Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter W.5, Section 3, 16, and 23.

That unless noxious weeds growing on their lands within the municipality of the Town of Petrolia are destroyed throughout the season, the municipality may enter upon the said lands and have the weeds destroyed, charging the cost against the land, plus an administration charge as set out in the Act. (Minimum charge per parcel is \$50.)

Long Grass

By-law 80 of 2008 specifies that "weeds and grass shall not be permitted to grow or stand greater than 20 centimeters (8 inches) in height." Under Section 9.4 and Section 10, if grass is not kept under 20 cm or 8 inches, the Town after notice is given will cut the property grass at the owner's expense.

Blowing Grass Trimmings to the Roadway All grass blown onto the roadway during lawn maintenance is not be left on the roadway or disposed of into catch basins.

The cooperation of all landowners is appreciated.

Trees are living, growing, renewing and majestic! As part of our global awareness of the environment, trees, particularly the urban forest plays a very significant role.

The Community Services Department is committed to the green spaces in the Town of Petrolia.

The Commemorative Tree Program, is a very special way of keeping Petrolia green. This partnership between the Community Services Department and Hillsdale Cemetery helps to fill a void, as no trees can be planted at Hillsdale.

For a very reasonable fee, you may purchase a tree which is planted in Fairbank Park in recognition of a loved one.

The tree will be planted in Fairbank Park, and will become a living tribute and remembrance.

Once a year a tree planting ceremony will occur in the fall (late October/early November), and at that time the current year recognitions will be unveiled as an addition to the permanent plaque at Fairbank Park.

Trees are planted as weather conditions permit in the fall each year.



Applications for commemorative trees are accepted year round.


