The Council of the Town of Petrolia held a public information session at Victoria Hall, Petrolia on Monday, November 28, 2022, regarding the 2023 Proposed Water and Sewer Rates.

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person at Victoria Hall, Petrolia on Monday, November 28, 2022. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Heard a delegation from the Kiwanis Club of Petrolia and Area regarding a Splash Pad Proposal.
- Received and filed a report regarding the 2022 third quarter financial results.
- Adopted the 2023 Municipal Fee Schedule as amended to reflect a change from the recommended \$300 for a new business license to \$250.
- Endorsed a report containing key recommendations regarding the Kiwanis Club of Petrolia and Area splash pad proposal, and that staff proceed with the process of budgeting, and develop agreements for approval at an upcoming Council meeting.
- Received and filed a report regarding compliance confirmation to section 270(1)(1) of the Municipal Act (2001); and acknowledged that the 2022-2026 members of Council endorse the current Town of Petrolia regulating policies and procedures known as By-Law 39-2018.

- Approved the following by-laws: 41-2022 Appointment of Acting Mayors for 2022-2026, 42-2022 Committee and Council Appointments, 43-2022 Committee of Adjustment Secretary and Alternate, 44-2022 Council Renumeration for the 2022-2026 term, 45-2022 Appoint Alternative Member to County Council: Joel Field, 46-2022 with amendment to maintain the second opportunity to address Council and to prevent the need for a motion for members of the public to address Council, and 47-2022 Drainage Act for payment of drainage work at the County Road Drian on Oil Heritage Road, and finally 49-2022 to authorize an agreement regarding an archaeology field liaison with The Chippewas of the Thames First Nation and the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia to Bright's Grove Water Treatment Plant Intake Replacement
