The Council of the Town of Petrolia held a Public Information Session online via Zoom on Monday, February 27, 2023.

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting online via Zoom on Monday, February 27, 2023. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Council heard a presentation from Matt Pearson of BM Ross regarding a Development Charges Study
- Council heard a presentation from Andrew Meyer, General Manager, Cultural Services Division regarding the Lambton County Library Joint Facilities Review
- Council heard a presentation from Baker Tilly Sarnia LLP regarding engagement letter reviews for the Reconnect Funding Reviews
- Council adopted a report regarding a Development Charges Study and authorized the use of BM Ross to conduct the study and authorized that the cost be funded by the Working and Capital Reserve.
- Council adopted and approved the report regarding the 2023 Town of Petrolia Budget.
- Council adopted the report regarding the quotation results for the emergency repair of the distribution line at Buttermilk Creek and awarded the repair to Clark Construction Inc. for \$54,000 plus HST.
- Council adopted and approved the report regarding Phase 1 of the Greenwood Estates development for performance acceptance and the two-year warranty period for the Municipal servicing of Phase 1 begins effective February 27, 2023.
- Council received a report regarding the requested follow-up information as it pertains to policing costs and calls for service.
- Council endorsed a report regarding the 2022 lottery update, and that the Council continue to waive the 3% licensing fee, and that a \$200.00 eligibility review fee be added to the Municipal Fee Schedule.
- Council adopted a report regarding the SCBA Decontamination Washing Machine Tenders and awarded the tender to Canadian Safety Equipment Ltd. In the amount of \$42,325.00 plus HST.
- Council approved the cancellation of the second crosswalk study and asked that staff return with a report.
