May 8, 2023– 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person at Victoria Hall, Petrolia on Monday, May 8, 2023. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Council heard a presentation from NPG Planning Solutions regarding the Official Plan document review.
- Council directed staff to proceed with an agreement and by-law that awards a six-year Greenwood Concession Operator agreement to Terri Den Boer, Owner, Gramma's Candy Store for \$4200.00 per year for 2023 to 2025 and \$4300.00 per year for 2026 to 2028.
- Council directed staff to proceed with a Service Agreement with Lambton County Developmental Services for the cleaning of sidewalks in the downtown core from June 19, 2023 to September 1, 2023 for an all-inclusive fee of \$3520.00.
- Council received and filed a report regarding Site Plan Amendment for Southwest Fence located at 320 Centre Street in Petrolia.
- Council received and filed the County of Lambton Manager, Planning & Development Services report regarding Bill 23.
- Council endorsed a report regarding Recording and Streaming of Council meetings; and that staff be approved to proceed with the quote in the amount of \$33,795.00 plus HST from Avolution Multimedia.
