#### **Further Renovations Complete in CEEH Acute Care Patient Rooms**

Renovations on two additional rooms at Petrolia hospital's acute care unit are now complete — including a dedicated palliative room. The completion of these latest room renovations add four fully renovated patient rooms to the acute care unit in Petrolia. The rooms have been renovated in two-room blocks to avoid delays in patient care.

These spacious and bright new acute care rooms are an early priority of the 25-year Charlotte Eleanor Englehart Hospital (CEEH) Redevelopment Project. Renovations include much-needed spacious and private bathrooms; updated with a shower to meet patient care and accessibility needs, including walker and wheelchair access.

"The newly renovated acute care rooms bring the rooms up to currentday standards, improve patient privacy and access, as well as the overall patient experience" says Dr. Charles Winegard, Medical Director, CEEH of Bluewater Health. "We are excited to see the beautiful results of infrastructure investments to our Petrolia hospital; updates our staff and patients can see and experience themselves."



- Don't let your sewer turn on you and your neighbours
   Never pour FOG down the drain!

#### PREVENT FOG (FATS, OIL and GREASE) in our sewers

#### What is FOG?

FOG (Fats, Oil and Grease) is the most common cause of sewer back-ups

FOG is a by-product of cooking and can be found in butter, margarine, salad dressing, gravies, sauces, lard, shortening, baking goods, meat fats and dairy.

Did you know the sewer system is only designed for the 3 P's? 1 Pee

- 2. Poo 3. Paper (toilet paper)

collect used grease and cooking oil in a container and dispose of it in the garbage

What can you do to help?

- wipe out visible fats, oil, grease and food residue from dishes, pots and pans with disposable paper towels
- put solid waste and food scraps in the garbage
- be aware of hidden FOG's in salad dressing, sauces, gravies, cheese and desserts
- use a strainer in the sink to remove excess food debris - encourage neighbours to keep FOG's out of the sewer



- pour oil and grease down the sink, drain or toilet
- scrape food scraps down the sink, drain or toilet
- pour liquid food down the sink, drain or toilet run hot water over greasy dishes or pans - the FOG will cool and stick to the inside of the pipes
- use a food waste grinder to get rid of food and grease use washable cloths to wipes greasy dishes clean
