

Council News in Brief

September 11, 2023– 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person on Monday, September 11, 2023. At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Council heard a delegation from Mr. Kevin Shaw regarding the trail along Tile Yard Road, an item last brought forward by Mr. Shaw in 2019.
- Council heard a delegation from Mr. Harry Froussious of Zelinka Priamo Ltd. regarding a noise by-law exemption to permit exterior improvements to Heidi's Your Independent Grocer. Council approved the exemption.
- Council heard a presentation from Mr. Ken Melanson from the County of Lambton regarding the adoption of the Town of Petrolia updated Official Plan.
- Council received and filed a report regarding the financial accounts.
- Council received and filed a report regarding the 2023 Second Quarter Financial Report.
- Council received a report regarding the 2024 Compost Transfer Site dates and approved the 2024 pass fee, events, and curbside wood chipping dates. With a request the passes, be made available online.
- Council accepted a report regarding the termination notice for operation of the mobile concession vehicle in Bridgeview Park and directed staff to produce a call for tender in early 2024 seeking a new operator.
- Council received and filed a report regarding the Victoria Hall emergency cupola repairs.
- Council adopted a report regarding the Deputy Mayor position; that will see an amendment to the Town procedural by-law and the creation of a permanent Deputy Mayor, through a council decision of an appointment each term of Council, from the current elected councillors. - Council adopted a report regarding Local Government Week, and that October 15-21, 2023, be declared Local Government Week in Petrolia, and that the October 23, 2023, 7:00 p.m. regular session be moved to 10:00 a.m. in the Victoria Hall theatre space.
- Council received and filed a report regarding the resignation of two youth members from the Petrolia Youth Advisory Committee; and accepted with regret the resignation of Ava LaPorte and Kiera Maw.
