GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

DEPUTY RETURNING OFFICER:

The Deputy Returning Officer (D.R.O.) is responsible for the conduct of the Election at the Voting Poll to which they have been assigned.

You will be required to set up your Voting Station one hour prior to the opening of the Voting Station and you will be required to remain after the Voting Station closes for a sufficient amount of time to accurately count your ballots.

You will also be required to attend a training session. This training will take place during an evening session, approx.. 3 weeks before Election Day.

The rate of pay for a D.R.O. is \$185.00 (including attendance at a training session)

POLL CLERK:

The Poll Clerk assists the Deputy Returning Officer with the conduct of the Election at the Voting Poll to which they have been assigned.

You will be required to assist with setting up your Voting Station one hour prior to the opening of the Voting Station and you will be required to remain after the Voting Station closes for a sufficient amount of time to assist with accurately counting your ballots.

You will also be required to attend a training session. This training will take place during an evening session, approx.. 3 weeks before Election Day.

The rate of pay for a Poll Clerk is \$150.00 (including attendance at a training session)

The date of the 2014 Municipal Election is **Monday October 27, 2014**.

Election workers are expected to arrive at their Poll Station at 9:00 a.m. and be ready to accept voters when the Polls open at 10:00 a.m.

After the Polls close at 8:00 p.m. election workers would proceed to accurately count their ballots, the DRO will deliver their ballot box to the Petrolia Town Hall.
