ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

Please note that certain materials need to be placed in set areas

Area A:

- leaves grass clippings
- weeds/garden plants/shrub clippings/hedge trimmings

Area B:

brush, capable of chipping (maximum length 6 feet, maximum diameter 4 inches)

Bags or containers of any description are not allowed to remain at the compost site. No animal feces.

Your Co-operation is appreciated For Inquiries please contact 519-882-2350

COMPOST is available for \$15.00 a cubic yard and may be purchased during regular operating hours. Anyone wishing to purchase compost must bring and load their own containers.

Only residents of Petrolia will be permitted entry to the Compost Site. Identification by Driver's License is required and will be requested on site by the Compost Custodian. www.town.petrolia.on.ca


