



Memorial Tree Program and Bench Program

Hello everyone! I hope you are finding my CAO's Corner articles interesting and informative. I know that municipal government impacts many important aspects in our daily lives and that municipal affairs can sometimes seem complicated and foreign which can lead to misunderstandings. The purpose of my articles is to help demystify the municipal world.

Today I wish to speak about our Memorial Tree Program and our Bench Program. These two important programs provide residents with the ability to recognize a loved one while contributing to the beautification of our outdoor environment. Upon request you will receive a contribution/donation receipt that can be used as an income tax deductible.



Memorial Tree Program:

Providing green spaces in Town is critical to the well-being of our residents. Our tree program provides people an opportunity to participate in a very special way in the greening of our Town. Our Memorial Tree Program offers four native trees: Freeman Maple; Tulip Tree; Flowering Pear and Kentucky Coffee. The trees are planted at Fairbank Park and will become a living tribute and remembrance. Once a year a tree planting ceremony occurs. More information is available on the Town website or by connecting with Town Hall.









Bench Program:

Benches are an important park amenity in our Town. These benches provide resting and viewing areas

for residents and visitors to sit, relax and enjoy the beauty of our Town's beautiful parks and trail system. A bench may be purchased in memory of a loved one or to honour a person, group or special occasion. The bench will be installed in an appropriate site, as chosen by the family from the locations set out by our Parks staff. Applications for benches are accepted throughout the year, and benches are installed on a cement pad base as climate conditions permit.

Now that you have an understanding of these two programs, hopefully, you will give them consideration.
