




Measuring & Reporting Progress

The purpose of this Strategic Plan is to guide decisions and action at the Town of Petrolia from 2024 to 2028. It establishes three priorities, nine strategies and 24 actions we will take.

On an annual basis, the Town of Petrolia will check in on the status of the actions identified in this Strategic Plan, and the Plan generally. Is progress being made? Is the Town making measurable improvements towards the priorities identified here? Has something in the community or broader landscape changed, requiring an adjustment to this plan?

An annual check in and summary Report Card on progress will enable Council, Administration and Petrolia residents to ensure progress is being made, and continue to engage in intentional conversations about priorities for the future of Petrolia. This is a particularly important way that the Town of Petrolia can continue to demonstrate high value to all residents -- and engage in open conversation about shared aspirations for the future.
