

Council News in Brief

March 25, 2024– 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person on Monday, March 25, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at Victoria Hall.

At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Heard a presentation from Sam Smith from OCWA and endorsed as presented the 2023 Brights Grove Water Treatment Plant report and received the MOE Inspection reports.
- Heard a presentation from Joe Bloomfield from JACOBS and endorsed as presented the 2023 wastewater treatment plant annual report.
- Received a report regarding the R1 and R2 quotes and awarded the project to Sevcon Construction in the amount of \$47,873.00 excluding HST.
- Approved that staff proceed with procuring the 2024 CASE 580SN TRACTOR LOADER BACKHOE through Delta Power for the purchase price of \$122,287.02 plus HST, as budgeted.
- Adopted a report regarding the Petrolia & Enniskillen Fall Fair approvals and granted significant event status to the event and provided an exemption to the noise bylaw (61-2009) and approved that the Clerk provide confirmation of same for their AGCO application.
- Approved a report regarding the request to re-post the request for proposal for Mobile Concession Vehicle Services – Bridgeview Park in a paper format with a minimum bid of \$3,500 per season.
- Adopted a report regarding the Arena/Parks and Recreation Truck RFP Results and approved that the tender for the supply of one four-wheel drive, crew cab pickup truck be awarded to Finch Auto Group for the purchase of a Silverado in the amount of \$49,566.50 plus HST.
- Received and filed a report regarding the March 2024 Committee of Adjustment meeting.
- Endorsed a report regarding the 2023 lottery update, and that the Town of Petrolia continues to waive the 3% licensing fee.
- Received and filed the 2023 vital statistics and council meeting attendance update as amended to add a missed committee.
- Received and filed a report regarding the 2023 remuneration and expenses, and annual public sector disclosure filing.
