Following an Education Session and a public meeting regarding ZBA WEST PART LOT 15, CONCESSION 10, the Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person on Monday, April 8, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at Victoria Hall.

At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Welcomed Mike Barron, Executive Director of the Sarnia Community Fund/Petrolia Community Foundation where \$11,450.00 worth of micro grants were presented to various community groups including: Noelle's Gift, Tammy's Place, Petrolia and District Skating Club, Petrolia YMCA, Lambton Literacy, No One Stands Alone, and the Kiwanis Club of Petrolia and Area.
- Tabled a report regarding Eureka Street Surplus Lands Roll # 381900002010212.
