### Article 1 INTERPRETATION

#### 826.1.1 Bicycle - defined

"bicycle" means a bicycle and tricycle. By-law 25-1989, 24 April, 1989.

#### 826.1.2 Boulevard - defined

"boulevard" means that portion of the street allowance of the Town which lies between the curb or edge of the travelled portion of the roadway and the property line, or may hereafter be so improved either by the Corporation or any owner or occupier of land in front of whose property such improvements may be made with the consent of the Council of the Town of Petrolia. By-law 25-1989, 24 April, 1989; By-law 48-1996, 10 June, 1996.

#### 826.1.3 Bus - defined

"bus" means a motor vehicle designed for carrying ten or more passengers and used for the transportation of persons.

#### 826.1.4 Commercial motor vehicle - defined

"commercial motor vehicle" means the motor vehicle having permanently attached thereto a truck or delivery body and includes an ambulance, hearse, casket wagon, fire apparatus or motor bus and tractors used for hauling purposes on the highway.

#### 826.1.5 Corner - defined

"corner" means the point of intersection of curbs or edges of the portion of the highway used for vehicular traffic.

#### 826.1.6 Crosswalk - defined

"crosswalk" means:

- (a) that part of a highway at an intersection that is included within the connections of the lateral line of the sidewalk on the opposite sides of the highway measured from the curbs, or in the absence of curbs, from the edges of the roadway; or
- (b) any portion of a roadway at an intersection or elsewhere distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossings by signs or by lines or by other markings on the surface.

#### 826.1.7 Cul-de-sac - defined

"cul-de-sac" means a highway or part of a highway having an outlet at one end only.

#### 826.1.8 Curb - defined

"curb" means the edge of the travelled portion of the highway.

#### 826.1.9 Disabled vehicle - defined

"Disabled vehicle" includes motor vehicle, traction engine, trailer and any vehicle, drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power, providing it has a disabled persons permit displayed.

#### 826.1.10 Emergency vehicle - defined

"emergency vehicle" means ambulance, fire department or police force vehicles, public utility emergency vehicles and public works department vehicles.

#### 826.1.11 Gross weight - defined

"gross weight" means the combined weight of vehicle and load.

#### 826.1.12 Highway - defined

"highway" includes a common and public highway, street, avenue, parkway, driveway, square, place, bridge, viaduct, trestle or lane designated and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles.

#### 826.1.13 Highway Traffic Act - definitions

The definitions set forth in section 1 of the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8 and amendments thereto, shall be deemed to be part of this Chapter as if set forth in full herein.

#### 826.1.14 PARKING - VEHICLE MOVEMENT

#### 826.1.14 Intersection - defined

"intersection" means the area embraced in the prolongation or connection of the lateral curblines or, if none, then that of the lateral boundary lines of two or more highways that join one another at an angle, whether or not one highway crosses the other.

#### 826.1.15 Loading zone - defined

"loading zone" means the part of the highway next to the sidewalk or curb and marked or indicated for loading or unloading merchandise or for taking on or letting off passengers.

#### 826.1.16 Official sign - defined

"official sign" means a sign approved by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.

#### 826.1.17 One-way street - defined

"one-way street" means a street on which vehicular traffic is limited to movement in one direction.

#### 826.1.18 Operator - defined

"operator" means a person who operates a motor vehicle on a highway.

#### 826.1.19 Park or parking - defined

"park or parking" when prohibited, means the standing of a vehicle whether occupied or not, except when standing temporarily, for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers.

#### 826.1.20 Parking space - defined

"parking space" means a portion of the surface of a highway designated as such by suitable markings.

#### 826.1.21 Peace officer - defined

"peace officer" includes a mayor, warden, reeve, sheriff, deputy-sheriff, sheriff's officer, justice of the peace, police officer, constable, police cadet, or other persons employed for the preservation and maintenance of the public peace or any officer including a provincial offences officer appointed for the enforcing or carrying out the provisions of this Chapter.

#### 826.1.22 Pedestrian - defined

"pedestrian" includes a person on foot and an invalid or child in a wheel chair or carriage.

#### 826.1.23 Person - defined

"person" includes a firm or company.

#### 826.1.24 PARKING - VEHICLE MOVEMENT

#### 826.1.24 Private property - defined

"private property" means property that has been clearly marked as such by fences or on which a legible sign or signs have been erected by the owner, occupant or an agent for either, forbidding trespassing or parking on a private road or driveway.

#### 826.1.25 Public holiday - defined

"public holiday" means a holiday fixed as such by statute or official proclamation.

#### 826.1.26 Public lane - defined

"public lane" means a passageway between buildings or properties which belongs to the Town or is a public thoroughfare.

#### 826.1.27 Public place - defined

"public place" means any place to which the public has or is permitted to have access.

#### 826.1.28 Roadway - defined

"roadway" means the part of the highway that is improved, designed or ordinarily used for vehicular traffic, but does not includes two or more separate roadways, the term "roadway" refers to any one roadway separately and not to all of the roadways collectively.

#### 826.1.29 Sidewalk - defined

"sidewalk" means a walk of raised path between the lateral lines of a highway and the adjacent property lines intended for use by pedestrians.

#### 826.1.30 Singular - plural - masculine - feminine

In this Chapter, unless the context otherwise requires, the singular number includes the plural, the plural number includes the singular, the masculine gender includes the feminine.

#### 826.1.31 Stand or standing - defined

"stand or standing" when prohibited, means the halting of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except for the purpose of and while actually engaged in receiving or discharging passengers.

#### 826.1.32 Stop or stopping - defined

"stop or stopping" when prohibited, means the stopping of a vehicle, with a complete cessation of movement, even momentarily, whether occupied or not, except where necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a peace officer or in a traffic control sign or signal.

#### 826.1.33 PARKING - VEHICLE MOVEMENT

#### 826.1.33 Through highway - defined

"through highway" means a highway or part of a highway designated as such by this Chapter and every such highway shall be marked by a sign approved by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.

#### 826.1.34 Traffic - defined

"traffic" includes pedestrians, ridden or herded animals or vehicles and other conveyances either singly or together while using any highway for the purpose of travel.

#### 826.1.35 U-turn - defined

"U-turn" means to turn a vehicle within a roadway so as to proceed in the opposite direction.

#### 826.1.36 Vehicle - defined

"vehicle" includes motor vehicle, motorized snow vehicle, traction engine, trailer and any vehicle, drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscular power.

### Article 2 GENERAL PROVISIONS

#### 826.2.1 Time - standard - daylight saving

Where any expressions of time occur or where any hour or other period is stated, the time referred shall be standard time except in periods of when daylight saving time is in effect, in which periods, it shall be daylight saving time.

#### 826.2.2 Enforcement - peace officer

A peace officer shall enforce the provisions of this Chapter.

826.2.3 U-turns - Highway Number 21 to Petrolia - prohibited No person shall make a U-turn with a vehicle on Petrolia Street between the most westerly limit of Highway Number 21 and the westerly limit of Petrolia Street. By-law 25-1989, 24 April, 1989.

#### 826.2.4 Speed - designated streets - forty km/h

No person shall drive a vehicle at a greater rate of speed than forty kilometres per hour on:

- (a) Dufferin Avenue and Louisa Street;
- (b) First Avenue between the school zone signs as posted;
- (c) Eureka Street and Maple Street, between the school zone signs as posted. By-law 25-1989, 24 April, 1989; By-law 21-1992, 9 March, 1992.

- 826.2.5 Materials other on sidewalk permission required No person shall cause any merchandise or building material or other material to be placed on any highway, sidewalk or public place unless he has obtained permission from the Town to do so.

- 826.2.6 Heavy vehicles with cleats on streets prohibited
  The use or operation of tractors, traction engines and all other heavy
  vehicles with metal flanges or cleats on their wheels, is prohibited on
  all streets within the Town of Petrolia except with permission of the

- 826.2.7 Vehicle entry onto street safety precaution

  Any operator of a vehicle emerging from an alley, land, driveway, lot or building shall stop the vehicle immediately prior to driving onto the roadway and shall not enter the roadway until he can do so in safety.

  No person shall operate or drive a vehicle upon or across any sidewalk,
  except at public street and alley crossings or at private crossings.
- **826.2.9** Peace officer obeyed at all times
  All operators shall promptly obey all the signals of a peace officer directing traffic.
- 826.2.10 Fire route obstruction prohibited

  No person shall stop, park or stand a vehicle so as to obstruct a designated fire route.

### Article 9 PRIVATE PROPERTY

No person shall park or leave any vehicle on private property without authority from the owner or occupant of such property.

### Article 10 BICYCLES

826.10.1 Person - steering - deemed driver

Any person steering a bicycle on a street shall be deemed to be the driver of such bicycle within the meaning of this Chapter.

826.10.2 Bell - horn - hooter - required - use - limitation

No bicycle shall be ridden on any street or public place unless it is equipped with a bell, horn or hooter, and such bell or hooter shall be used only as a signal of danger and not to make a harsh, prolonged noise.

826.10.3 Use - at night - light - reflector - requirement

No bicycle shall be ridden on any street between one-half hour after sunset, and one-half hour before sunrise, unless it has at the front, a lamp throwing a white light and in the rear, either a reflector or a lamp throwing a red light, and every such light must be visible a distance of sixty metres.

#### 826.10.4 Prohibited - areas - riding on street

No person shall ride a bicycle on the sidewalk on Petrolia Street:

- (a) on the south side between Oil Street and Princess Street; and
- (b) on the north side between Tank Street and Kerby Street.

#### 826.10.5 Passengers - prohibited - designed - single use

No person riding on a bicycle designed for carrying one person only shall carry any person thereon.

#### 826.10.6 Riding - full control - requirement

No person shall ride a bicycle on any street unless he has full control of such bicycle by his feet on the pedals and both hands on the handlebars.

#### 826.10.7 Obstruction - pedestrians - vehicles - prohibited

No person shall operate or leave a bicycle in such a place or manner as to obstruct the passage of pedestrians and other vehicles.

#### 826.10.8 Registration - required - fee - \$2

The owner of every bicycle who is a resident of the Town of Petrolia, shall register it with the police force before driving or operating upon any street within the Town and shall pay to the force a fee not to exceed \$2 for the registration of such bicycle.

#### 826.10.9 Registration - in parent's name - owner under 16

Where the owner of a bicycle is under the age of sixteen years the bicycle must be registered in the parent's name or guardian's name.

#### 826.10.10 Permit numbered - issued - each bicycle

The police force shall issue for every bicycle so registered, a numbered permit, which shall become a permanent permit for the said bicycle.

#### 826.10.11 Registration plate - affixed - location

The registration plate shall be affixed to the rear fork or front post of the bicycle.

#### 826.10.12 Serial number - missing - permit - prohibited

No permit shall be issued for a bicycle unless the manufacturer's serial number or similar identification mark is stamped on such bicycle.

### Article 11 PARADES - PROCESSIONS

826.11.1 Driving through - permission - peace officer - required No person shall drive a vehicle through a procession, including a funeral procession, except with the permission of a peace officer.

- 826.11.2 Funeral driving near right hand edge single file
  The driver of a vehicle in a funeral or other procession shall drive as

- 826.12.2 Vehicle pedestrians unauthorized prohibited No vehicle other than fire vehicles or police vehicles and no pedestrians, other than firemen, police and others having business there, shall remain or approach within 100 and 150 metres of the scene of the fire.

### Article 13 PEDESTRIANS

- 826.13.1 Obstruction sidewalks street corners prohibited Pedestrians shall not obstruct sidewalks or street corners.
- 826.13.2 Congregation three or more people
  Where three or more persons are congregated they shall be subject to the direction of the police.
- **826.13.3** Walking on road prohibited sidewalks provided Where sidewalks are provided, no person shall walk along or upon an adjacent roadway.

  Where sidewalks are not provided on a highway, a pedestrian walking


