Following the Public Information Meeting regarding planning and/or development – Southside ZBA and OPA, the Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting in person on Monday, June 24, 2024, at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at Victoria Hall.

At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:
