January 13, 2025 – 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

Following a Public Meeting hosted by the County of Lambton regarding Phase 9 of Countryview Estates/Elbee Investments, the Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting of Council on Monday, January 13, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at Victoria Hall.

At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Received a report regarding the keeping of backyard chickens; and directed staff to maintain status quo with respect to keeping of livestock in residential zones, including the keeping of backyard chickens.
- Received and filed a report regarding the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation of Canada Grant.
- Approved a report regarding consolidated linear infrastructure implementation as required by the province; and approved that Misener Engineering complete the Consolidated Linear Infrastructure Inspection, Reporting and Inventory Support study at a cost of \$29,971.00 plus HST.
