

# Council News in Brief

April 14, 2025 – 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

Following an Education Session held at 5:00 p.m., the Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting of Council on Monday, April 14, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at Victoria Hall.

At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Presented certificates of recognition of the Petrolia Oiler U18 B Team International Silver Stick Championship Team and the Petrolia Oiler U13 B Championship Team International Silver Stick
- Received a delegation from Mr. John Krent regarding invoice relief of by-law enforcement charges. Council approved the waiving of the invoice.
- Heard a presentation from the Sarnia-Lambton Economic Partnership.
- Received and filed a report regarding the April 2025 Committee of Adjustment meeting.
- Approved that the Lambton County Board of Health proceed with the West Nile Larvicide program in Petrolia in 2025.
- Received and filed a report regarding 2025 Heritage Tax Rebates.
- Endorsed a report regarding the approval of the Canada Housing Infrastructure Fund (CHIF) capital grant and approved the creation of the Transfer Payment Agreement which will be sent by the Federal Government.
- Received and filed a report regarding the Long-Term Debt Analysis at the end of 2024.
- Received and filed a report regarding the 2025 first quarter report of the incident responses, inspections, apparatus use, and public education events of the Petrolia and North Enniskillen Fire Department.
- Received and filed a report regarding the acquisition of the One Ton Dump Truck and provided the Director of Operations with the single use authority to acquire the dump truck, as budgeted, through sole source purchase.
- Endorsed a report regarding a road closure request for June 14, 2025, and approved the road for closure with public notification to be sent by the Clerk.
- Received and filed a report regarding the Brights Grove Water Treatment Plant Intake replacement – Update #2 – Award of Tender and approved that Stone Town Construction Limited of St. Mary's be awarded the Brights Grove Water Treatment Plant Intake replacement project in the amount of \$14,139,432,93 including HST.
- Mayor Loosley presented a motion to remove Councillor Ross O'Hara as the Council Representative for the St. Clair Conservation Authority and appoint himself to the seat.
