May 12, 2025 – 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting of Council on Monday, May 12, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at Victoria Hall.

At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Heard a delegation from Mr. Kelly Humphries, Petrolia and Enniskillen Agricultural Society, regarding an ATV Race, and requested that staff provide a report back to the next meeting regarding traffic and other details.
- Received a presentation from the Lambton OPP Detachment Board regarding 2024 reporting.
- Received and filed the financial accounts from March 8 – May 2, 2025.
- Deferred a report regarding the Municipal Code dissection process until consultation with the Petrolia Business Association is completed, and that the new overnight parking end date be moved to April 1.
- Received and filed a report regarding Strong Mayor Powers that are now in effect for Petrolia Council.
- Received and filed a report regarding the 2024 Petrolia and North Enniskillen Fire Department Annual Report.
- Adopted a report regarding the Lambton County Developmental Services (LCDS) Downtown sidewalk cleaning and directed staff to proceed with a service agreement with LCDS for the cleaning of sidewalks from June 2 - August 22, 2025.
