The Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting of Council on Monday, June 23, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at Victoria Hall.

At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia request that the Chief Building Official return to council at the July 15 Council meeting with information relating to concerns raised that some requirements contradict building and fire code, such as any window that opens into the pool enclosure area must be made that it cannot open more than 4"; and THAT a copy of the concerns in whole received from the resident will be forwarded for to the CBO; and THAT as part of the clerk's current review of the fencing by-law as part of the municipal code dissection that the pool fence by-law also be returned to council for review and amendment, to remain current to today's needs; and THAT messaging begins being distributed through the Town's communication tools regarding pool fencing.
