

Council News in Brief

October 27, 2025 – 7:00 p.m. – Regular Meeting of Council

Following the Public Information Meeting regarding OPA and ZBA for Countryview Phases 4-8, the Council of the Town of Petrolia held their regular meeting of Council on Monday, October 27, 2025, at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers at Victoria Hall.

At this meeting, the Council of the Town of Petrolia:

- Received and filed a report regarding a status update on the Concise Asset Management Plan and endorsed the 2026 Concise Asset Management Plan.
- Received and filed the 2025 Third Quarter Report regarding incident responses, inspections, apparatus use and public education events of the Petrolia and North Enniskillen Fire Department.
- Directed staff to initiate a public engagement for suggestions of what the name for the park located at the new soccer fields north of the Petrolia YMCA should be.

Take notice that at the November 10, 2025, council meeting, I, Councillor Chad Hyatt, with a seconder will bring forward for consideration the following motion;

WHEREAS the Town of Petrolia recently received two (2) grants for the Petrolia Line watermain upgrade;
AND WHEREAS the development charges background study forecasted zero (0) grants for this project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia request that staff review the calculated development charges for development areas 1, 2, & 3 and bring forth an amendment to the by-law schedule to reflect decreased development charges as applicable due to the grant funding.

THAT By-Law Number 33-2025 being a by-law to permanently stop up, close and sell a portion of a municipal right-of-way shown on Registered Plan 3, Petrolia more particularly described as Part 2 on Reference Plan 25R5624 located within the lands known for municipal purposes as 4320 Discovery Line, Town of Petrolia, County of Lambton be read a third time and finally passed.

THAT By-Law Number 34-2025 a By-Law of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia to authorize the execution of an agreement with his Majesty the King in right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Infrastructure and Communities (the Minister of Housing and Infrastructure and Minister responsible for Pacific Economic Development

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Canada) for the purpose of receiving funds under the Government of Canada Housing Infrastructure Fund to accelerate the construction and upgrading of housing-enabling drinking water, wastewater, stormwater, and solid waste infrastructure. (CHIF) be read a third time and finally passed.

THAT By-Law Number 35-2025 being a By-Law of the Corporation of the Town of Petrolia to Confirm the Resolutions and Motions of the Council of the Town of Petrolia which were adopted up to and including October 27, 2025, be read a third time and finally passed.
